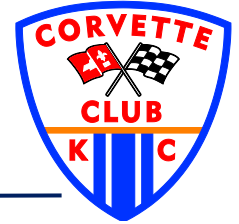

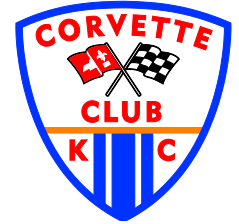


December Event:
