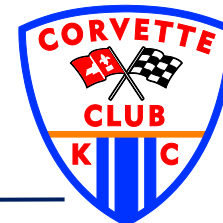

### Culver's Cruise

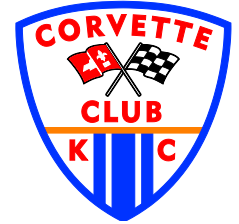

**Treasurer:** **Jim Juliff** advised we are behind for the month (very minor) but ahead for the year.

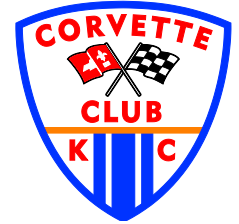
**National Corvette Museum (NCM):**

**Tech Talk – by Chuck Levenson****Cold Temperature Cracking of Michelin Tires**

A new GM Bulletin has reportedly been issued stating: "Avoid driving, moving, or test-driving Corvettes equipped with Michelin Pilot Super Sport ZP tires below -7°C (20°F) as operating at these temperatures can cause damage to the tires." While surfing GM's



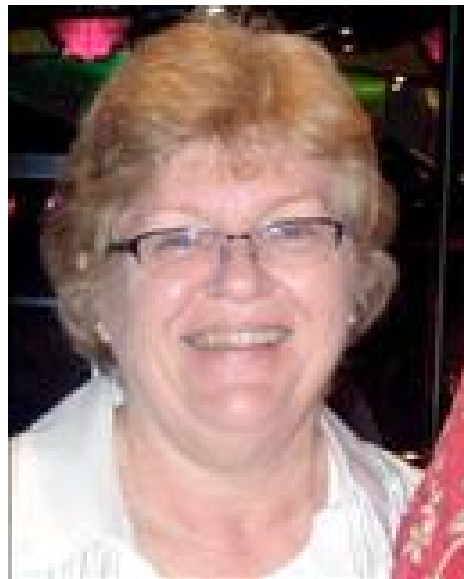
website, your Hi-Beams editor was not able to confirm the existence of this bulletin. Several postings from the Corvette Community even described low temperature cracking of the Michelin's All Season "A/S" tires. Urban myth of fact? Don't know, but I would suggest checking your tires for any signs or cracking.

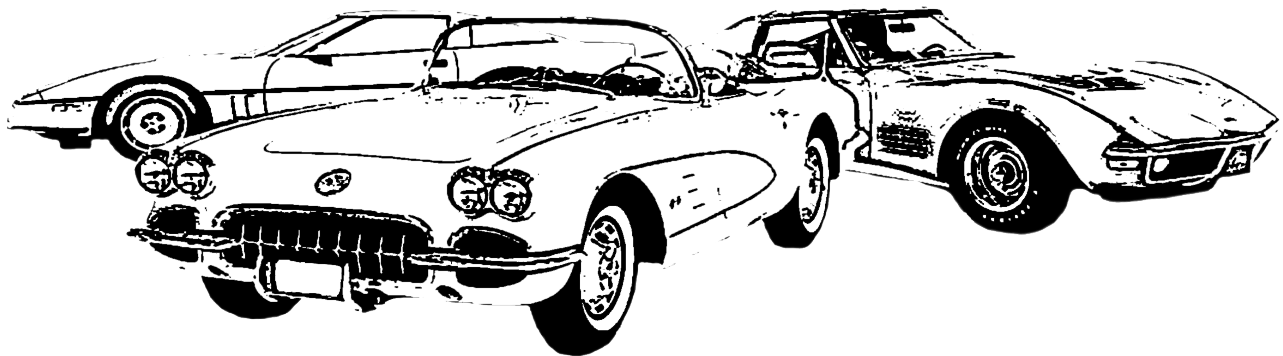

# J. Rieger & Co. Distillery Tour & Lunch

- Following the tour we will have lunch at Pigwich, a food truck affiliated with The Local Pig, a butcher shop located across the street from the distillery.
- Cost: \$25 per person; this includes lunch and a \$15 store credit to be used at the J. Rieger distillery store.
- **Bonus:** If you want to stick around after the tour you can taste whiskey, cork whiskey bottles, and assist the distillery in labeling the daily production of the bottles of whiskey.
- Meet at 12:00 PM at Bass Pro Olathe to caravan to the East Bottoms, we will depart from Bass Pro at 12:15 PM, the distillery tour begins at 1:00.
- The parking lot at the distillery is small, it will accommodate approximately 20 Corvettes and is paved.
- The tour involves a lot of standing, one flight of stairs, and walking; we don't sit down until lunch.
