

It was a rainy day but it did not stop us from enjoying the Sinkler-led cruise around Perry Lake, a group lunch, and a visit to the Dole Center.



## CCKC April 15, 2015 Meeting Minutes



Mike also asked for a show of hands to determine interest in a Kansas City Royals Cruise to the K on August 16<sup>th</sup>. Details will be announced later.


May 11 – Cruise to Grinders in Lenexa hosted by Gene and Vicki Sinkler. It will start at 5 with dinner to follow at 6:30.

After the raffle, the meeting was adjourned.





Pei-In and Don Speers went to Las Vegas to take their hand at driving the new Z06. Don said that he strictly followed the track posted speed limits during his outing.





