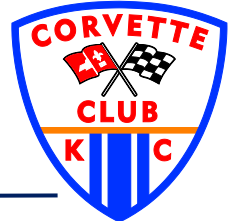

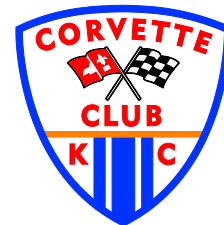

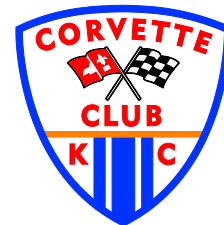

Thanks to the members for their donations along with the acquired donation from the Vietnam Veterans, secured by Roland Norris, our event was also a financial success.

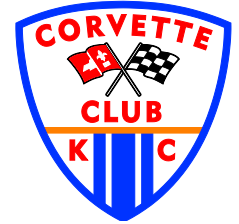
The net proceeds from our event will go to the Center to purchase bus passes for the Veterans - Gwyn Hill

On Wednesday, May 20, 2015, at 7:00 PM, the CCKC meeting held at Uncle Buck's/Bass Pro was called to order by **President Jim Cahill**. There were approximately 62 people in attendance.

There were no representatives from Hendrick in attendance.

Jim Cahill announced Vicki Sinkler would serve as the CCKC Membership Chairperson for the remainder of the year.

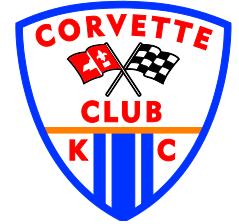
Secretary: Linda Downing thanked Colleen Juliff for taking minutes at the April 2015 meeting in her absence. Linda obtained approval of the April 2015 meeting minutes as published in the Hi Beams.

Treasurer: Jim Juliff advised we are ahead of budget for the month and for the year.

National Corvette Museum (NCM): Adam Hoehn announced the Skydome reconstruction is scheduled to be completed in July. He advised the groundbreaking for the Holley Control Tower at the Motorsports Park is scheduled for May 28. Registration is now open for the 21st Anniversary Celebration (celebration of the Grand Opening of the museum in 1994). Adam also advised that if the club wanted to purchase another parking lot banner, August is when the museum changes out the car club parking lot banners. Banners stay up for one year and then are

returned to the car club. Banners are raised each August and will be up for the 21st Anniversary celebration. The cost for the club banner is \$500. A vote was obtained and the majority voted to purchase a club banner; there were 4 who voted in opposition. A motion was made and approved for purchase of the parking lot banner. The club currently has a NCM membership which allows for a free ad; Kathy Denning and Jim Cahill will get an approved announcement to Adam so the club can advertise the club's Zona Rosa show.

Rieger Distillery tour on 5/9, stating all had a good time and appreciated the "friendship" of the distillery owners. Cynthia stated the 5/11 outing at Grinders was cold but there was a large turnout and all had a good time. On 5/16, there were 25 cars that traveled to St. Michael's Center, a nice collection of cars; she thanked all who helped with the show. Roland Norris stated he was able to obtain a \$300 donation from the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 317 and a \$40



donation from Hyvee, which went towards some of the food purchased for the event. The remainder of the donations went towards the purchase of \$250 of bus passes for the veterans. He thanked all who brought dessert and assisted with the event.

6/26 Bloomington Gold, Chuck Levenson is leading 7 corvettes to the show from this area; contact Chuck if you are interested

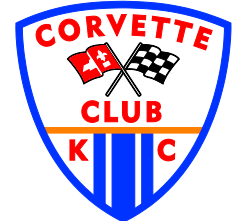
