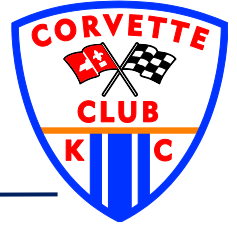

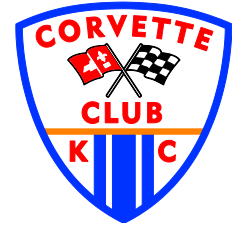
January Events:

**January Minutes:**

On **Wednesday January 18, 2017** at 7:00pm, the meeting was called to order by President Steve Garrett at Uncle Buck's/Bass Pro Shop. There were approximately 75 members present.

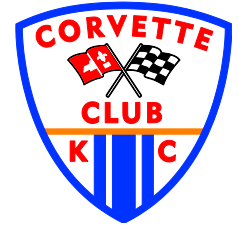

- Jim Juliff is putting together a trip to Ankeny Iowa; an

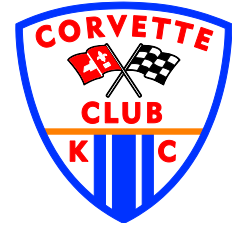

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25pm.

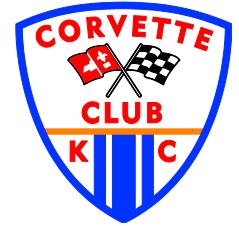

Tech Talk/News:

Shock Absorber Assessment C1 thru C7 – Chuck Levenson

At no later than 60,000 miles you should begin routine inspection of your cars shock absorbers by doing the following:

- (1) Inspect for any signs of oil leakage on the shock tubes.
- (2) Inspect the rubber mounting bushings for wear.
- (3) Inspect the tire tread for uneven wear; this may indicate shock absorber problems.
- (4) Apply downward force at each corner of the car – it should only rebound 1 time. If the car bounces the shock absorber(s) are not functioning properly.
- (5) If the car bounces after rapid grade changes, e.g., speed bumps or following hard braking (nose down and rear end up followed by bouncing) the shock absorbers are not functioning properly. These events may be more easily observed by watching your car while somebody else drives it.



Diagnostic Codes on C4 and C5 Vettes – Jeff Moss

One great feature on C5 Corvettes in particular and C4's to a lesser extent is access of Diagnostic Trouble Codes on the vehicle without need of a code reader or scan tool. Not all data will be available and there will be occasional need to use a reader at the OBD port but quite a bit of information on the vehicle and various modules is available and can be useful if you are having intermittent problems or are simply assessing the health of a vehicle. The internet often provides useful guidance/resources regarding resolution of these codes. I've provided two links below, one for C4 and the other for C5 if you are interested.

Mike McGinley, former GM at Hendrick Chevrolet asked that we post the following Corvette items for sale. Anyone interested can text or call Mike at (913)915-1504, or email Mike at mikemcginley50@gmail.com . Mike can text or e-mail pictures of the parts.

1.) 2008 Corvette Z51 Coupe LIKE NEW factory wheels and tires. I converted the car to a SCCA T1 race car when it was new so these wheels and tires came off and have been stored inside Hendrick Chevrolet Parts since new. Probably

100 miles on the tires. The wheels are the stock painted (silver) Z51 wheels in as-new condition, 18" fronts and 19" rears. The original Goodyear Eagle F1's are P245/40ZR18 fronts and P285/35ZR19 rears. \$900 for set.

2.) Stock 2008 Z51 body panels- both front fenders and both rear quarters (Jetstream Blue Metallic). These are factory GM panels, the rears came on the car new and the front fenders are GM replacement panels. I converted the car to GS bodywork in late 2011 to accommodate bigger wheels and tires. These are in good used condition and still have all the race stickers and sponsor decals from the 2011 SCCA National Championship race where the car finished 3rd. These would also make great Garage Art! If you buy these panels from GM today the front fenders are \$586 each and the rear quarters are \$908 each. I will sell the front fenders left and right for \$200 per side. I will sell the rear quarters left and right side for \$300 per side. The left side quarter does not include the gas door. I will sell all 4 panels together for \$800.

3.) CCW C10 wheels- I used these as race wheels after I converted the body to GS/Z06 configuration. These are for use on the wider body not the stock Z51. 2 front wheels are 18" x 10" with 7 1/2" backspace and the 2 rear wheels are 18" x 11" with 9 1/4" backspace. Since the SCCA rules required the tires fit inside the wheel wells we ran spacers on the rear wheels to clear the inside fender well. One of the front wheels has a slight bend on the inside edge from dropping off a rumble strip (not visible to the eye but noticeable on a tire machine). It can be easily repaired. These wheels sell for \$3,000+ per set. I will sell the set for \$1,200.



4.) New Hoosier Rain Tires- 4 Hoosier rains 275/40R17. These tires are brand new and still in shipping bands, but they are old (purchased in late 2009). A new set is \$1300+. I will sell these for \$500 for all 4.

All of the parts are here in KC; buyer pays the freight if they need to be shipped. Thanks for your help.

The C7.R's finished 8th and 16th overall in the 55 car grid (4th and 9th in the 11 car GTLM class grid).



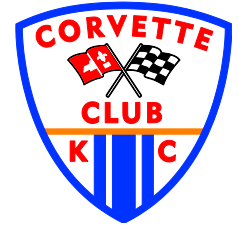
