
CCKC Corvettes head back to Bowling Green

On **Wednesday May 17, 2017** at 7:00pm, the meeting was called to order by President Steve Garrett at Uncle Buck's/Bass Pro Shop. There were approximately 65 members present.



After the meal, there are many shops there for people to enjoy, or for those who don't care to shop, there are benches to sit on to shoot the breeze and digest some good food.


When people have had their fill of shopping there, there is an Amish grocery store that is interesting, and they usually have some baby deer, or other such critters for us to pet and enjoy.


