On Wednesday August 16, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., the meeting was called to order by President Steve Garrett at Uncle Buck's/Bass Pro Shop. There were approximately 48 members and guests present.

We had a moment of silence for our member Elaine Holmes who recently passed away. She will be missed.

VP John Hamblin showed us the raffle items for tonight's raffle. Raffle items were donated by Chuck Levenson, John & Carol Hamblin, Hendrick Chevrolet, Uncle Buck's, Jim Cahill and Chris & Steve Shinners.

Steve Garrett told us Hendrick has 28 Corvettes on the lot including a few 2018 models.

Adam Hoehn, our NCM ambassador, told us the NCM Anniversary event registration closes tomorrow, August 17, 2017 although on-site registration will be available. A new event at the Anniversary event is Shifting and Shooting which will be held at a gun range.

Adam reminded us to go to Smile.Amazon.com when ordering from Amazon so that ½% will go to your preferred charity.

Our corporate sponsor from Hendrick was not present tonight.

Secretary Julie Dailey obtained approval of the July 2017 minutes.

Treasurer John Southerland thanked Barb Kearns and the picnic committee for a great event that even came in under budget. He reported the income and expenses for the month. We have raised \$2,600 for our charity so far. The Treasurer's report was approved.

Chris Shinners, Membership Chair, reported that total membership is now 197 with 3 memberships pending. Visitors tonight are John Caron, who is a first-time visitor and has a 1961 black Corvette with red interior. He has had it for 10 years and it

will be up for sale soon; Tom & Theresa Young, who just bought a 2004 black coupe.

Steve Shinners, who, along with his wife Chris, are the event coordinators for our Zona Rosa show, reported that, to date, only 18 members have signed up for the Zona Rosa show. He also told us that Oakes Automotive, who sponsors other area car events, will be bringing donuts and coffee to our event. Steve encourages us to please come! We need you to come! Additional information that Barb Kearns shared with us regarding the Show and Shine at St. Michael's: This is an event that Gwyn Hill is putting together to have a barbeque for the veterans. The budget would be for 140 people (120 residents of St. Michael's and 20 CCKC members). A short discussion ensued on whether to take the money for this event from the general operating fund or from the money that is going to the charity anyway. A vote was taken and the money will come from our operating fund.

Barb Kearns gave a short report about the picnic. The weather was wonderful as was the food. Leftover food was divvied up among the coordinators and the rest was taken to St. Michael's by Gwyn Hill.

Steve Garrett introduced Scott Foutch of Foutch Brothers who talked to us about Stonegate Motor Plaza...its history and where it is headed. Stonegate began 14 years ago and there are other facilities around the country like it. They build high-end garages. Joe Effertz is the owner and got Scott involved. They have City Council approval to start on the race track and it should be complete in 2018. Quality people have been hired to engineer the track. Others have been hired for track management and for promotions. The garages are separate from the track and they are still working out details about the rates that will be charged. There will be a simulator at the track. You can use the simulator to race in real time someone who is driving on the track. Stonegate will be hosting Cars & Coffee on Sept. 9 and on Sept. 16, they are holding Bloomapalooza. The Royals former pitcher will be there and there will be a barbeque and a concert.

Our raffle collected \$146; \$25 was deducted for the raffle, leaving \$121 for our charity.

The meeting adjourned at 8:02 p.m.


