thorough and engaging presentation on how our National Air Space is guarded and controlled. It was such an interesting presentation and garnered so many questions that we ran out of time!

Of course, everyone asked about 911 and what it was like to ground every single non-military flight in the US! There were close to 4,300 flights in the air when the head of the Air Traffic Control System Command Center

(ATCSCC) in the DC area gave the command to clear the skies. It was his first day on the job.

Safely guiding planes through highways in space means tracking Mother Nature, too! Weather is such an





Our venue is the Metropolitan Community College Blue River Precision Driving Center. This is a multi-purpose venue used by the Metropolitan Community College to train law enforcement officers and students the vehicular control skills they will need out in the field. The portion of the site used for this event includes a 400' by 400' concrete pad for paddock and grid, and a highly configurable urban track offering a mix of concrete and asphalt surfaces. There are no curbs anywhere on site, and there is ample run-off room in case a competitor experiences an off-course excursion.

Directions to site:

- Take I-70 to Highway 291 North (Independence)
- Take 291 North about 2 miles to 23rd Street / Highway 78
- Turn right (east) on 23rd Street / Highway 78 and go east for about 2 miles to the Metropolitan Community College.
- Proceed past the College and the SPCAA east on Highway 78 about another 1/2 mile.
- At the bottom of the hill, there is a road to the right, Powell Road, that leads to the Precision Driving Center. There will be a banner marking the location visible from the highway.


