Steve acknowledged that the Newell's are both doing very good recovering from medical issues. Steve thanked Robert Wiegiers for tonite's hospitality.

Robert Wiegiers, Corporate Sponsor from Hendrick Chevrolet welcomed us to the dealership. He pointed out the three new cars on display in the back of the room and thanked the members for their support of the dealership. He introduced two additional Hendrick employees that work and support our club.

Gene Sinkler, Vice President announced the evening's raffle items donated by Hendrick Chevrolet, Barb & Tom Kearns and Rick Eisberg. Ticket sales totaled \$181.00.

Steve asked that all new members see Debbie Meek, Hi Beams editor, to have their picture taken for the newsletter.

Sunday June 3rd – Hendrick Car Show: Steve mentioned we have started working on this event. We need volunteers to work the day of the show. Jerry Keith mentioned parking volunteers were also needed. Sign up sheets are available on the tables.

Steve Garret mentioned he will be organizing some drives to get members and **their cars on the road!**

Special Guest: Mike McGinley, retired GM of Hendrick, talked briefly about Sports Cars Club of America and Corvette racing. He invited members to come out and what to expect and passed out brochures with all the information. See the brochure in this Hi Beams editor or go to www.kcrscca.org.

Steve stated that Robert will take all members on a tour of the Service Area. Fred added that they have Corvette specialist here to work on the cars.

NEW & OLD BUSINESS

Discussion and Update on Van for St. Michael's. Steve informed members that we have been working with Terry Franz from *Cars for Heroes* to provide transportation to the veterans at St. Michael's. To make this a reality we had to connect a few dots, but now believe we are at a point to move forward. The van is free, but St. Michael's needs to cover the cost of fuel and insurance.

Barb Kearns stated that Gwyn had talked with Susan Engel from St. Michael's asking if they would be interested in receiving the van and explored how we might address concerns about how to cover the insurance, gas, maintenance and driver. The club has a volunteer to drive the van. The other issues were still a concern to St. Michael's.

Barb further stated that she had been doing research on the cost of insurance. Barb received estimates of about \$2,000 which is the same cost estimates Susan had received. The monies the club gave to St. Michael's in 2017 are already earmarked for the 2018 operating budget. Van expenses are not in their budget as they were unaware of the possibility of being gifted the van when the budget was approved.

Because the van may not be available for much longer, Chuck Abbott put together a budget that would allow the club to cover the following estimated van operating costs: insurance \$2,000; title & licensing \$250; and gas and general maintenance \$1,750. Residents from St. Michael's would be asked to give \$1 for each ride and St. Michael's estimated they could likely contribute \$1,000 to the gas and maintenance costs. This would leave the club with a total cost of approximately \$3,000.

It was proposed that the club give St. Michael's \$3,000 to secure the van. This amount would be an

advance that would be deducted from the charitable contribution given to St. Michael's at the end of 2018.

The following questions/concerns arose prior to a club vote on the issue. Some questions will be taken back to St. Michael's for further discussion, but will not affect the outcome of tonight's vote:

1. *Does St. Michael's really want the van?* Answer: Barb stated yes, but she will reconfirm this with Susan Engel.
2. *Will the van be titled in St. Michael's name?* Answer: Yes. CCKC will have no responsibility or liability regarding the van.
3. *Is the insurance higher because of the location of St. Michael's?* Answer: No. It is commercial insurance not individual insurance. The club will have zero liability.
4. *If St. Michael's has a choice to take the van and receive less at the end of the year or take a lump sum at the end of the year, which would they prefer?* Answer: Gwyn will put this question to Susan and we will proceed according to her response.
5. *Dianne Keith raised the question where this money is coming from and will we be able to replenish this money at the end of the year?* Answer: Steve stated we have the money in our savings now. Additionally, if we do not raise at least \$3,000 by the end of the year for the charity we will not be donating any additional money to them.
6. *There was another question raised that could not be heard by the secretary.* Chuck Abbott stated that we had adequate funds in our savings account and, based on our preliminary review of our 2018 budget, we will have adequate funds to not only cover the \$3,000 upfront payment but have sufficient funds available to make an additional contribution to St. Michael's.

Steve asked for the motion and second to approve advancing St. Michael's \$3,000. The motion/vote carried.

Followed by the **Raffle and Closing**, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.

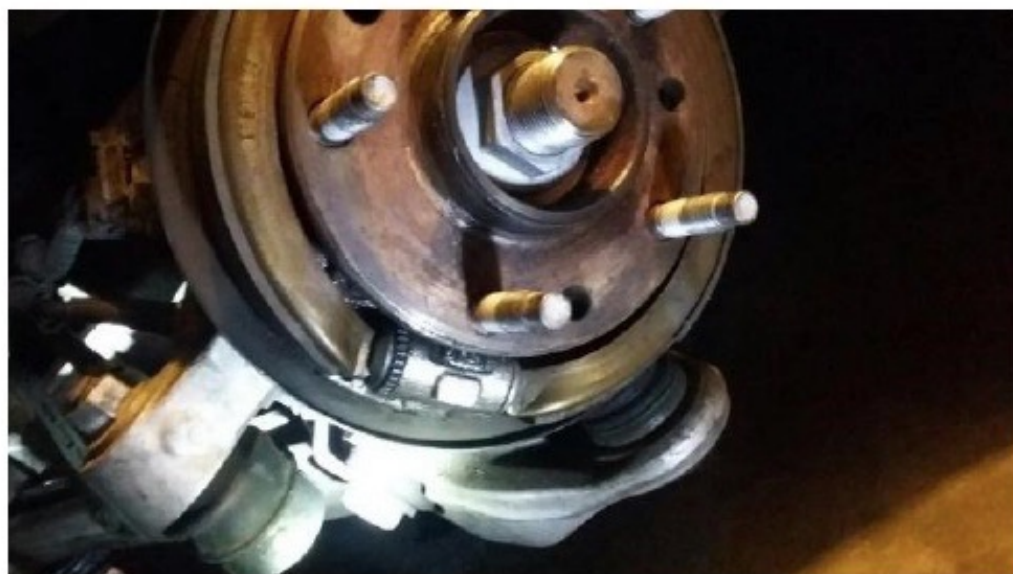
C5 Parking Brake Technical Article

C5 Parking Brake Adjustment Procedure.

I found the need to adjust the parking brake when my 1999 Corvette would not hold the car on a small incline. The parking brake did not work well even when the car was new. This is what I did before I took the car for its PV last year.

The parking brake works like those on most cars with rear drum brakes. Start with jacking up the rear of the car and removing the wheels. Remove the bolts from the calipers, then the calipers and pads. There you will see the brake backing plate. The bolts for the backing plate are torqued to 125 ft pounds with Loctite from the factory. I had to use a long breaker bar to loosen the bolt.

With the brake backing plate off you can remove the brake rotor. You can now see the parking brake shoe ring. Now locate the star adjuster and turn it out to make the shoes grow in diameter. I noticed it took about 30 clicks to get mine tight. I would suggest doing about ten clicks on the star adjuster at a time then slid the rotor back on checking the fit. Once there is a little drag on the rotor, back the adjuster off 2 clicks. This will allow the rotor to slide on smooth then your good. At this point you can reassemble the backing plate and the brake caliper with the pads.



Do the same with the other side. Now you can test the cars parking brake. It should hold on a hill.

AN OPEN LETTER TO CCKC

Hello,

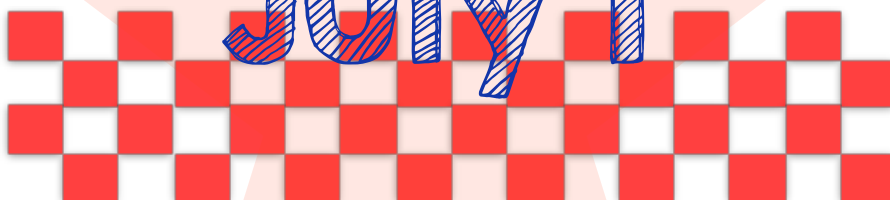
