
YOU OUGHTA' BE IN PICTURES!






Chase, the manager of *Culver's* is happy to sponsor CCKC again for our monthly Culver's Cruise. Terry and Bob Henn will host the event again this year.

food and desserts. Chase also donates several free meal and dessert coupons.


