



## **C5** Acid Mat Protection

C5 owners known the battery sits right above that all important main computer system. Protecting that system from a costly battery acid leak that could wreck ALL KINDS OF HAVOC costs no more than the CCKC raffle tickets! That's right for just \$5.00 you can purchase an Acid Mat from Battery Mart or other retailer.



## **C6 Windshield Vibration**

"Good, Good, Good Vibrations!"
this is not. For C6 owners, GM missed
a clip when they assembled all the C6's!
You can cruise a while without it, but as the
car ages, that extra anchoring can be useful.
You can order the missing clip from your GM
Dealer. The cost is about \$8.00. The image
to the right shows the clip, where it should
be positioned and the GM part number.



## **C7** Pulsating Breaks

Does your brake pedal feel like it's vibrating when you apply the brakes? It could be a brake pulsating problem that SOME C7 owners are experiencing.

GM has not issued a recall (not model-wide) but has issued Service Bulletin #16-NA-170. Your dealer will fix this problem—free of charge—by removing your 2-part rotor and replacing it with a single rotor.

# TSB #16-NA-170 030000 BRAKES (PWS) bulletin for the 2014 CORVETTE This technical bulletin provides a procedure to replace either the front or rear rotors for the condition on a pulsation and/or vibration when they apply the brakes. 





Located at 24607 N 7 HWY, Pleasant Hill, Mo.


