Tech advice, by Chuck Levenson:

Now that some of our "newer" Corvettes, C5-6-7's, have rolled to higher mileage, it is time to think about new spark plugs and wires. It is probably best for you to change plugs and wires in the +50,000-mile range, rather than waiting for the 97,500 miles that the C7 manual says.

New Corvettes come with Iridium spark plugs. Iridium is one of the longest lasting type of spark plugs available. Both Platinum and Iridium plugs have a higher electrical resistance than Copper, which would mean that a Copper spark plug should have a hotter spark; but the longevity of Copper spark plugs is greatly reduced. Considering the difficulty in accessing and changing the plugs in some Corvettes, Iridium is probably the best choice.

This year's judges will not be club members.

Do not trust the old wires with which the car came! A close inspection will probably reveal some heat cracking, and since they can be difficult to extract, there may be internal damage. Considering how hard it can be to remove the old plugs and install new ones, it is best to replace the wires as well.
