## Debut of the C8.R, 24 Hours at Daytona

Corvette Racing entered two new C8.R cars in a 24-hour endurance race at Daytona. It was an excellent opportunity to see how reliable the new mid-engine Corvette would be.

The results were mixed.



The #3 car (Mellow Yellow) had no significant problems other than that it did not have the peak top speed that the BMW's and the Porches were able to muster down the long straightaway. The good news is that it seemed

to have better handling, which allowed it to finish fourth in the GTLM class, only one lap behind the winning BMW M8 GTE.

The #4 Car (Hi-Ho Silver!) had issues with oil leaks. Eventually, they had to pull the engine to fix the problem. Perhaps this was related to the new flat-plane-crank engine, which is faster revving, but has more vibration then the cross-plane-crank engine that is standard on the production Corvettes. Car #4 did finish the race running, but it was 48 laps behind the leaders!



It looks like the addition of Jordan Taylor to the Corvette Racing Team will be a big bonus.

The next test for Corvette Racing will be another endurance race, 12-hours long, March 18<sup>th</sup>, at Sebring International Raceway.
