May Club Meeting was an online ZOOM Meeting with the following minutes:

On Wednesday June 17, 2020 at 7:09 pm, the monthly meeting of the CCKC was called to order by President, **Steve Garrett**, via Zoom teleconference.

Adam Hoehn, National Corvette Museum Ambassador: Adam stated that not a lot was going on due to the pandemic. Recently the museum is having what they call Vette Academy for children. They provided a lot of neat information like how one of the artist showed them how they began the making of a corvette with a concept drawing, history of concept cars after the C8 was introduced and other interesting information and events.

The museum is slowing opening with social distancing in place. They will be starting their track events also.

To date Amazon has donated \$645.79 to the museum from Smile.Amazon.com for last quarter. Amazon has given totally \$11,345.04 to the Corvette museum and to all other charities Amazon has donated over one hundred million dollars.

Meeting adjourned at 8:02pm


